NO MINUTES OR FINANCIALS WERE GIVEN.


THE MAYOR RECEIVED A PHONE CALL FROM THE COUNTY CLERKS

PREVIOUS YEAR 2010.


JACK FIELDS A MOTION FOR THE YEAR 2011 FOR ZERO MILLS AND WAS

AND WAS GIVEN RESOLUTION #2010-00.

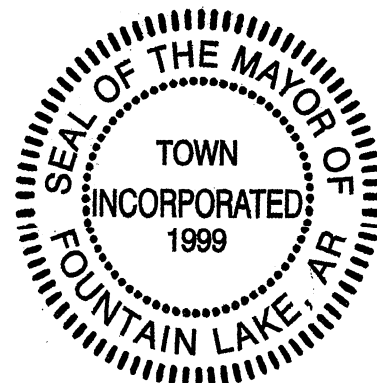
CARL RADER BROUGHT BEFORE THE BOARD CONCERNS GIVEN TO HIM BY


