

Minutes of the 16th Meeting of Town Council of Fountain Lake, Arkansas August 29, 2002

Meeting was called to order at 7:004 by Mayor Roy Hickman. Willard Ragsdale gave the invocation. Roll was called and a quorum was found to be in attendance.

Roy stated that the county Judge had applied for a grant of \$70,000 to disperse brickets in standing water throughout the county to help control West Nile Virus. He stated that he would have follow up information as soon as it is available.

He also stated that a memo from the Arkansas Munidpal league listed estimated turnback monies for next fiscal year from \$62.45 to \$62.00.

Roy presented a resolution to be passed by the council requesting that the Garland County Clerk add David Vaughn to the voting rolls of Fountain Lake, as it has been determined that his residence is within the corporate limits of Fountain Lake.

Jerry gave the road report. He stated that he and Roy had driven all the roads and surveyed the conditions with the following results:

Mungle Trail needs 2 culverts at \$80 each and 8 loads of SB2 at \$135 each plus \$150 for grading & ditches totalling \$1,390.

Because the contractor must rent a grader for a minimum of 4 hours, it was proposed that the unused hours be used to regrade Hillvale Garden Trail for 4 hours at \$75.00 per hour.


Bud McKinley Road needs repairs to paving totalling \$980. Mowing of Bud McKinley has been completed for a total of \$50. The repair of the ditches authorized at the Council Meeting of July 25th will be completed as soon One Call marks the location of utilities.

It was noted that candidates are signed up for all council positions for the next election.

It was decided that the September and October meetings of the council will occur on the normal last Thursday of those months, but that the November meeting will be skipped and a final meeting of this council will occur on Monday, December 2, 2002.
