

MINUTES OF THE 34TH MEETING OF
THE TOWN COUNCIL OF FOUNTAIN LAKE, ARKANSAS
JANUARY 17, 2005

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 7:00 PM BY MAYOR QUALLS WITH ALL MEMBERS PRESENT.

THE MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING WERE READ AND APPROVED.

OLD BUSINESS

MAYOR QUALLS REPORTED THAT THE COMPUTER FOR THE TOWN HAS BEEN PURCHASED BUT THAT HE HASN'T PURCHASED THE SOFTWARE YET.

NEW BUSINESS

MAYOR QUALLS READ ORDINANCE 2005-01 ESTABLISHING THE BUDGET FOR 2005. A MOTION WAS INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN JERRY WRIGHT AND SECONDED BY ALDERMAN CLYDE VAUGHN TO APPROVE THE ORDINANCE. THE ORDINANCE WAS APPROVED BY A VOTE OF THE COUNCIL.

A MOTION WAS INTRODUCED BY IVAN LOPES AND SECONDED BY JERRY WRIGHT TO PURCHASE A SIGN TO BE PLACED UNDER THE FOUNTAIN LAKE FIRE DEPARTMENT SIGN UPON THEIR APPROVAL TO ANNOUNCE THE DATES OF THE TOWN COUNCIL MEETINGS. THE MOTION WAS APPROVED BY A VOTE OF THE COUNCIL.

CLYDE VAUGHN SUGGESTED PURCHASING DEAD END SIGNS FOR OUR ROADS AND IVAN AGREED TO LOOK INTO THE COST OF THESE SIGNS.
