MINUTES FROM THE 118^{TH} TOWN COUNCIL MEETING THIS WAS HELD ON MAY 12, 2014.

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JACK FIELDS. MEMBERS PRESENT WERE JIMMY ATTEBURY, JAMES DRIVER AND FRANK PFENENGER. MEMBERS ABSENT WERE PETE DOW AND TOMMY QUALLS. MR. JOHN HOWARD AND MR. MICKEY GATES WERE ALSO PRESENT.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY FRANK PFENENGER AND $2^{\rm ND}$ BY JIMMY ATTEBURY TO ACCEPT THE MINUTES AS WRITTEN. ALL WERE IN FAVOR NONE OPPOSED.

THE FINANCIAL TOTALS WERE GIVEN AND A MOTION WAS MADE BY JIMMY ATTEBURY AND $2^{\rm ND}$ BY JAMES DRIVER TO ACCEPT THEM AS WRITTEN. ALL WERE IN FAVOR NONE OPPOSED

FINANCIAL COMMITTEE: NONE

ROAD COMMITTEE: MAYOR JACK FIELDS IS STILL WORKING ON TRYING TO GET MOWING STARTED AND ALSO SUGGESTS HOLDING UP ON ANY PAVING ON LEJUNE RD UNTIL A BIGGER CULVERT IS PUT IN.

OLD BUSINESS: MR. HOWARD BROUGHT BEFORE THE BOARD THE CLEANED UP VERSION OF THE JAIL AGREEMENT FOR MAYOR JACK FIELDS TO SIGN SO IT CAN BECOME OFFICIAL AFTER BEING TURNED BACK INTO THE JUDGE. A COPY WILL BE RETURNED TO THE CITY FOR ITS RECORDS.

MR. HOWARD ALSO STATED THE LETTER OF COMITTMENT WITH THE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT OFFICE HAS NO ISSUES OF CONCERN AND SUGGEST THAT THE TOWN GOES AHEAD AND EXECUTE IT. THE LETTER BASICALLY SAYS THE TOWN OF FOUNTAIN LAKE AGREES TO COOPERATE AS THEY PUT THE HAZARDOUS MATERIAL PLAN TOGETHER.

NEW BUSINESS: MAYOR JACK FIELDS PRESENTED THE BIDS FOR THE ROAD PROJECTS TO BE COMPLETED IN 2014. HE HAS RECEIVED BIDS FROM REDSTONE, SALTCREEK AND SPA FOR PAVING ON ZANDER, LAJUNE, BALTZELL AND POPS PLACE. TO SEE ALL BIDS SEE ATTACHED PAPER WORK. MAYOR JACK FIELDS READ ALL BIDS FOR THE ROADS AND HOPE THE BOARD WILL APPROVE 2 ROADS TO BE DONE NOW AND ONE IN THE FALL. A MOTION WAS MADE BY FRANK PFENENGER AND 2ND BY JAMES

DRIVER TO ACCEPT THE LOWEST BID FOR PAVING WHICH WAS FROM SPA FOR ZANDER AND BALTZELL RDS. THE BIDS FOR ZANDER WAS \$14,190.00 AND BALTZELL WAS \$9,990.00 WITH A MOBILIZATION FEE OF \$1,000.00. FRANK PFENENGER ASKED WHAT THE CHEAPEST ROAD OUT OF THE 2 REMAINING WERE FOR PAVING AND WHO HAD THE CHEAPEST BID THE MAYOR INFORMED HIM IT WAS POPS PLACE AT \$12,225.00 WHICH WAS FROM SPA ALSO. FRANK.PFENENGER ASKED IF IT WOULD SAVE THE TOWN ANY MONEY TO ADD POPS PLACE TO THE ROADS TO BE PAVED NOW. MAYOR JACK FIELDS STATED IT WOULD SAVE THE TOWN MOBILIZATION FEES IN THE FALL IF THE TOWN WENT AHEAD AND APPROVED IT NOW. A MOTION WAS MADE BY JIMMY ATTEBURY TO PAVE POPS PLACE NOW INSTEAD OF IN THE FALL AND IT WAS 2ND BY FRANK PHENENGER. ALL WERE IN FAVOR NONE OPPOSED.

A DISCUSSION WAS MADE ABOUT THE FUNDING OF THE ROAD PROJECTS AND A MOTION WAS MADE BY JAMES DRIVER TO MOVE \$40,000.00 DOLLARS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE STREET FUND FOR PAVING. IT WAS $2^{\rm ND}$ BY JIMMY ATTEBURY ALL WERE IN FAVOR NONE OPPOSED.

A MOTION TO ADJOURN WAS MADE BY JIMMY ATTEBURY AND $2^{\rm ND}$ BY FRANK PFENENGER. ALL WERE IN FAVOR NONE OPPOSED.
