MINUTES FROM THE 132<sup>nd</sup> TOWN COUNCIL MEETING THIS WAS HELD ON  
OCTOBER 12, 2015.

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JACK FIELDS. MEMBERS  
PRESENT WERE JIMMY ATTEBURY, JAMES DRIVER AND FRANK PFENENGER.  
MEMBERS ABSENT WERE RICK QUALLS AND PETE DOW. SHERIFF MICHAEL  
MCCORMICK AND JUDGE RICK DAVIS CAME TO THE TOWN MEETING LATE.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY FRANK PFENENGER AND 2<sup>ND</sup> BY JIMMY ATTEBURY TO  
ACCEPT THE MINUTES AS WRITTEN. ALL WERE IN FAVOR NONE OPPOSED.

THE FINANCIAL TOTALS WERE GIVEN AND A MOTION WAS MADE BY JIMMY  
ATTEBURY AND 2<sup>ND</sup> BY FRANK PFENENGER TO ACCEPT THEM AS WRITTEN. ALL  
WERE IN FAVOR NONE OPPOSED.

OLD BUSINESS: MAYOR JACK FIELDS BROUGHT BEFORE THE BOARD THE  
RECOMMENDATIONS THAT WHEN THE CITY BECOMES 2<sup>ND</sup> CLASS IT WILL DO AT  
LARGE AND THAT WE WILL PIGGY BACK THE SPECIAL ELECTION ON JULY 12,  
2016.

NEW BUSINESS: A MOTION WAS MADE BY FRANK PFENENGER TO PIGGY BACK  
THE JULY 12, 2016 SPECIAL ELECTION AND 2<sup>ND</sup> BY JIMMY ATTEBURY ALL WERE IN  
FAVOR NONE OPPOSED.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY JIMMY ATTEBURY AND 2<sup>ND</sup> BY JAMES DRIVER TO HAVE  
THE CITY BE AT LARGE FOR ELECTION. ALL WERE IN FAVOR NONE OPPOSED.

MAYOR JACK FIELDS DISCUSSED SOME OPTIONS WITH THE SHERIFF AND JUDGE  
THAT THE TOWN WILL HAVE TO DO WHEN BECOMING A TOWN OF 2<sup>ND</sup> CLASS.

MAYOR JACK FIELDS BROUGHT BEFORE THE BOARD A RESOLUTION FOR  
LEVYING ZERO MILLS OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR THE TOWN OF FOUNTAIN  
LAKE, AR FOR THE YEAR 2016. A MOTION WAS MADE BY JAMES DRIVER AND 2<sup>ND</sup>  
BY JIMMY ATTEBURY TO ACCEPT THE MOTION AS WRITTEN ALL WERE IN FAVOR  
NONE OPPOSED.

MAYOR JACK FIELDS BROUGHT BEFORE THE BOARD THAT MR. FRANK  
PFENENGER IS MOVING FROM THE TOWN AND IS OFFERING THE TOWN THE  
CHANCE TO BUY HIS PROPERTY AT \$95,000 IT'S A HOUSE AND 10 ACRES. MAYOR  
JACK FIELDS WILL GET THE LAND APPRAISED AND GET BACK TO THE BOARD.

FRANK PFENENGER TURNED IN HIS LETTER OF RESIGNATION TO THE TOWN DUE  
TO HIM MOVING OUT OF THE CITY. HE RETURNED HIS SAFETY DEPOSIT KEY BOX.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY JIMMY ATTEBURY AND 2<sup>ND</sup> BY FRANK PFENENGER TO
