

Minutes of the 12th Meeting of Town Council of Fountain Lake, Arkansas March 28, 2002

Meeting was called to order at 7:04 by Mayor Roy Hickman. Don Nobles gave the invocation. Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved. Roll was called and a quorum was found to be in attendance. The financial report was given.

Jerry was called on to give his report as to the progress of the road committee. He started by suggesting that the council might want to adopt the same rules as the county for new sub divisions and roads that will be turned over to the city. He did not have a copy of the county regulations available and it was decided to continue that matter next meeting.

Roy brought up a road condition requiring consideration by the council concerning a culvert that has been crushed by the school bus. It was decided to get an estimate from a private contractor to remedy the situation and also to examine the possibility of the school bus turning around elsewhere. Another man wanted his road graded due to recent rain damage. It was discussed that only part of the road is in Fountain Lake and it was decided that we would get an estimate to regrade the road and also that Roy would talk to the County Judge to see if they might grade the road as part of it is county.

Roy mentioned that people should consider running for the council as there would be a few vacancies later this year.

Jerry continued on the subject of roads, particularly the repair of Hillvale Garden Trail and Old Stagecoach Trail. He contacted 5 contractors, three of which bid on the job. After lengthy discussion, it was decided to award a contract to Tim Jackson to do the work. He was requested to present a schedule of time for completion of the work, a copy of his insurance and to obtain a performance bond for the job.

Roy presented a request from the State for us to verify a map that they sent us of our town boundaries. It was suggested that we have more maps printed and that we furnish a copy of our map to the State with the differences between the two noted.

The council passed a resolution that would allow any council to authorize Tim Jackson to perform emergency repairs on city roads on a per hour basis.

Jerry moved that the meeting be adjourned, it was seconded and passed and happened at 8:40
