Minutes the 43rd Council Meeting (Special Session)
August 3, 2006

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 by Mayor Qualls. All council members were present except Margaret Bushong. This is a special session called specifically to vote on the annexation approved by Garland County on June 28th.

Tim Stockdale moved that in order to facilitate the process, the council vote on the option of bypassing the required 3 readings of the ordinance for annexation and only require on reading of the ordinance. It was seconded by Ivan. It passed unanimously in a roll call vote.

Mayor Qualls read the proposed ordinance (#02-006). Clyde moved that the council pass the ordinance, Ivan seconded and it was passed unanimously. Don Nobles reported that the annexation had added approximately 300 acres to the Town of Fountain Lake.

Clyde requested that Rick read the names of the new members of the town. It was done

Clyde asked what was happening on the installation of street lighting. Rick said that the only thing needing to be done was that the intention to install the lights be publicly published, per requirements of Entergy. It was suggested that it be done in the Village Voice.

Jerry reported that Mountain Pine was ready to commence with the mowing of the road sides on Monday morning. The cost will be \$120.00/hour and the delivery of the equipment will be approximately \$250 per trip. He said that we needed to vote on accepting JMC Lane into the town, but it was noted that that had happened at the last meeting
