

ORDINANCE NO. 2007-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FOUNTAIN LAKE OPTING OUT OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF SHIELDING DEVICES ON STREET LIGHTING

WHEREAS, the Legislature in 2006 made certain technical corrections in the Act to allow for certain opt out procedures by municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fountain Lake has limited resources and is located in a primarily rural area.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FOUNTAIN LAKE, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Act 1963 of 2005 the City of Fountain Lake Arkansas has made a determination that the cost of acquiring shielded outdoor lighting fixture is more expensive than the alternative fixtures and is therefore prohibitive, after comparing the cost of the fixtures and the projected energy cost for the operations of the fixtures.


SECTION 2. Therefore the City of Fountain Lake hereby opts out of the application of such statute.

Now, therefore an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance being necessary for the preservation and advancement of the public peace, health and safety, shall take effect and be in full force from and after the date of its approval.
