ROAD COMMITTEE: CULVERT WORK IS BEING DONE ON ROADS.

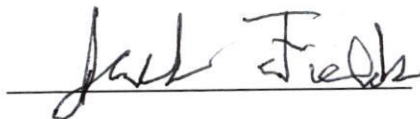

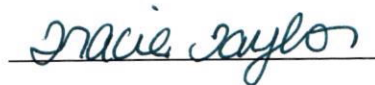
